English

We will be writing stories to begin the half term, using Jack and The Beanstalk as the stimulus. We will have a week of writing poetry and then move onto writing reports about climates and the continents which will link to geography learning. Writing in sentences with accurate punctuation remains a focus.

Every morning, there will be RWI groups for either phonics or reading comprehension, spelling and handwriting or grammar work.

History & Geography

We will be learning about climates and why some plants are only found in certain parts of the world. We will be using maps to locate rainforests and use atlases to explore climates around the worlds and revising the 7 continents and 5 oceans of the world.

PSHE & RE

In RE, we look at the question: How special is the relationship that Jews have with God? We will look at the importance of the mezuzah in everyday life.

In PHSE, we are looking at Zones of Regulation and how they can be useful in all areas of our lives.

Science

PLANTS

We have started to learn about seeds and bulbs so now will be looking at mature plants and what a plant needs in order to grow and stay healthy.

We will be completing some investigations to help us learn about those needs.

Maths

This term, we will be exploring some new topics such as position and direction, statistics, and fractions. We will continue to work with numbers using all four operations through daily recall and arithmetic tasks and applying them to help us solve problems. We will continue to follow the mastering maths program, exploring basic number concepts such as the value of numbers to 20 and known facts within that.

Key maths vocabulary

Data, graph, pictogram, key, axis, parts, whole, fraction, left, right, above, below, between, difference, total, altogether, more than, less than, equal to.

Physical Education

The unit this half term is invasion games. The children will be learning about the principles of defending and attacking in order to score goals. They will learn how to gain possession of the ball and how to mark an opponent.

Music

This celebrates a wide range of musical styles. We will learn some new songs and participate in some composing and performing.
